Insurance Requirements

1. Event Partner prior to commencing work shall provide at its own expense evidence of the following insurance placed with insurance companies licensed or “admitted” in each state where an event will be held and rated A or above by Best Rating. Each policy shall require, and each certificate shall indicate, that, thirty days prior to cancellation or material change in the policies, notice shall be given to Taste of Home Productions, Inc. (“Company”), by registered or certified mail, return receipt requested, for all of the following stated insurance policies. Company should be named an additional insured on all required insurance contracts.

A. Worker’s Compensation-Statutory. Coverage to comply with the compensation laws of all states.

Coverage Section A:	Statutory limits
Coverage Section B:	\$1,000,000 Bodily injury by accident each accident
	\$1,000,000 Bodily injury by disease policy limit
	\$1,000,000 Bodily injury by disease each employee

B. Commercial General Liability Insurance. With a minimum combined single limit of liability per occurrence of \$1,000,000 for bodily injury, personal injury, or property damage; \$2,000,000 aggregate. This insurance shall indicate on the Certificate of Insurance the following coverages:

1. Premises - Operations
2. Independent Contractors and Subcontractors
3. Products and Completed Operations
4. Broad Form Contractual
5. Broad Form Comprehensive General Liability

C. Automobile Liability Insurance. With minimum combined single limit of liability of \$1,000,000 for bodily injury and property damage. The insurance shall include the following coverages:

1. Owned automobiles
2. Hired automobiles
3. Non-owned automobiles
4. Mobile equipment (if not covered under B above)



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- D. Umbrella Liability. \$4,000,000 each occurrence/aggregate.
2. If at any time any of the foregoing policies are or become unsatisfactory to Company, as to form or substance, or if a company issuing any such policy is or becomes unsatisfactory to Company, Event Partner shall upon notice to that effect from Company promptly obtain a new policy and submit the same to Company for approval, which will not be reasonably withheld.
 3. Upon failure of Event Partner to furnish, deliver and maintain such insurance as provided above, the agreement between Event Partner may, at the election of Company, be declared suspended, discontinued or terminated.
